

Maylen Calienes, is an award-winning producer, writer, director. She was born in Cuba and raised in Miami, FL where her career began in writing, directing and acting for theatre. In Los Angeles, CA she has established herself in the indie film world. Calienes has written, directed and produced several films, which have played at some of the top film festivals. Two of the films she produced the Student Academy Award Winning Film "Esta es tu Cuba" and "And The Brave Shall Rise" have been Academy Award contenders. Her comedy The Three Bilinguals has received international attention and awards.

Maylen is an advocate of diversity and inclusion in the entertainment industry and founded Latino Filmmakers Network, a nonprofit organization, in 2015 at the Sundance Film Festival to bring visibility, opportunity and proper representation to the Latiné community. She is co-founder of Que Eye TV.com a platform for Bilingual (English/Spanish) voices to expand the narrative.

She is co-founder of Multi- Studios a longand short form content film studio that specializes in commercially viable and diverse stories that have an impactful and lasting social message. "The Shadow of theSun" the latest movie she executive produced is the official selection for Venezuela for Best International Feature Film for the 96th Academy Awards.

Morales has been featured in magazines such as People (US), Ego (Dubai), and Versus (Puerto Rico). Early in her fashion career, Melissa won an apparel design contest from Teen Vogue magazine and JustSweet. In addition, she was picked as one of the Top 100 designers to watch by ustrendy.com.

In 2018, her first book, A Gracious Hot Mess: Navigating Friendship, Love, and Life in NYC, was published. The next year, Melissa was highlighted as an author by the HBO Resource team during Hispanic Heritage month. This event took place at the HBO corporate office. The same year, Morales completed a Psychology of Leadership certification from Cornell University.

In February 2020, her script for A Gracious Hot Mess was selected to represent the Latino group in the New Normal Reading Series-East coast edition. Her second book, called *The Meta Gamers*, was published in 2020. In 2022, Melissa was featured at Comic Con PR. Her books are being sold on Amazon and Walmart.com. Both of her books have been featured on the coveted Times Square billboards. More recently, her work managing projects and products has brought her accolades and an award from her peers in the fashion industry.

"Being a selected LFN filmmaker granted me the full Sundance experience with a jam-packed itinerary. The opportunity to pitch your feature script at Sundance is a golden ticket for filmmakers like myself. LFN helped open my networking circle and proved to me that my voice and stories matter. I am incredibly grateful that I was able to keep in touch with the filmmakers I met at Sundance and had a handful of generals lined up. The feature I pitched at the 2020 LFN Sundance house is called Hija de tu Madre, which is currently in

development. My latest film is called Kid Ugly. It's a western short film that was created in association with McDonald's."
